

Goishi Coast Campground Terms & Conditions

1. Introduction

The Goishi Coast Group Facilities District Management Council (hereinafter referred to as the “Administrator”) has established these ‘Terms and Conditions’ to set forth necessary rules regarding the use of the Goishi Coast Campground (hereinafter referred to as the “Campground”). All users must agree to these terms and conditions and make use of the campground in accordance with the guidelines provided by the staff of the Goishi Coast Information Center (hereinafter referred to as the “Center”).

Periods of Operation, Hours of Operation, Available Facilities, and Usage Fees shall be specified separately

2. Registration

Applications and registration for use of the Campground shall be completed in accordance with the procedures outlined below.

Please note: Applications and registration by telephone or in person are accepted from 8:30 a.m. to 5:15 p.m.

(1) Application Process

Applications must be made at the Center reception desk by phone, fax, email, or through the reservation website.

(2) Registration Procedure

- ① Registration shall be completed at the Center counter.
- ② After submitting the Campground Use Application Form (Form No. 1) and paying the usage fee, users shall receive a Campground Use Approval Form (Form No. 2-1) and a Permit (Form No. 2-2). Users may then begin using the Campground.
- ③ Upon checkout or discontinuance of use, users must return the permit and any rented items.

3. Payment of fees

Usage fees shall be paid before use, either in cash or by cashless payment methods.

4. Important Regulations and Activities that are Prohibited within the Facility

Violation of the prohibited activities and/or non-adherence to the precautions and mannerisms that are to be observed in the Campground as stated below, and a failure to follow improvement instructions by users may have the following consequence: the user may be terminated from using the Campground and will be obligated to bear the costs of the damage incurred.

(1) Prohibited Activities

- ① Transferring or subleasing the right to use the Campground to a third party.
- ② Engaging in sales activities or providing food and beverages without permission.
- ③ The posting and distribution of posters and other printed materials without permission.

- ④ Use of the Campground by high schoolers and students below 18 years of age.
- ⑤ Smoking within the National Park, including the Campground.
- ⑥ Entering the Campground with pets.
- ⑦ Parking and driving in areas outside the designated areas.
- ⑧ Using facilities without permission.
- ⑨ Building open fires or using fireworks.
- ⑩ Feeding wild animals or collecting, cutting or removing plants or other natural resources.

(2) Precautions/Campground mannerisms

- ① Comply with the check-in and check-out times.
- ② Each auto-site parking lot is generally limited to one vehicle (multiple motorbikes are allowed).
Large vehicles that cannot fit must park in the Goishi Coast parking area.
- ③ Vehicles of free-site users must be parked in the Goishi Coast Parking Area, except when loading or unloading.
- ④ Do not use or move facilities or equipment for purposes other than their intended use.
- ⑤ When using charcoal or firewood, use the stoves provided in the kitchen building or auto sites, or fire pits and stoves brought by users. Exercise extreme caution when handling fire. After confirming that embers and ashes are completely extinguished, dispose of them in the desi
- ⑥ Separate garbage according to the instructions of the Center staff and dispose of it in the designated garbage disposal area.
- ⑦ In order not to disturb other users or nearby residents, please keep noise to a minimum and spend time quietly after 10:00 p.m.

The matters listed here are provided only as examples. Even actions not specifically mentioned may still be subject to violation penalties or improvement instructions.

Therefore, users must observe public order and morals and must not engage in any behavior that causes inconvenience to others or is deemed to interfere with the preservation, maintenance, or orderly operation of the campground.

5. Cancellation of Reservations

If you wish to cancel your reservation, please do so through the Center reception desk by telephone, fax, email, or via the reservation website.

Cancellation fees are as follows:

<p>If the reservation is canceled by the day before the date of use ※ <i>For the seafood set: cancellation must be made at least 4 days before the date of use</i></p>	<p>No cancellation fee</p>
<p>If there is no prior notice (no-show) ※ <i>For the seafood set: for notices that are 3 days or less prior to the date of use</i></p>	<p>100% will be charged</p>

6. Exemption from usage fees

Exemptions from usage fees shall be as follows.

When applying for a fee reduction or exemption, please submit a Campground Use Application Form (Form No. 1).

(1) Types of Exemption

① Full Exemption

When activities are organized or co-organized by the administrator.

② Half Exemption

When events are conducted by kindergartens, nursery schools, certified childcare centers, elementary schools, junior high schools, special needs schools, or similar institutions.

(2) Other

When the administrator deems that an activity or project is particularly necessary for the public interest.

7. Revocation of Approval of Use

Approval for use shall be revoked in the following cases:

- (1) When activities contrary to the original purpose of use are identified.
- (2) When false applications, fraud, or other improper acts are identified.
- (3) When users violate prohibited or cautionary matters stipulated in these regulations and fail to follow improvement instructions.

8. Unforeseen Circumstances and Handling of Personal Information

- (1) The administrator may close the facility or change conditions of use due to weather warnings/advisories, outbreaks of disease or infectious illnesses, the issuance of emergency declarations or to prevent the spread of infections.

The administrator shall bear no responsibility for unforeseen incidents or expenses, including usage fees, arising from failure to follow revised conditions.

- (2) No refunds will be provided unless the facility use is suspended due to natural disasters, facility malfunctions, disease, or infectious outbreaks.

If use is suspended due to external factors such as disasters, accidents, or infection prevention measures, or by decision of the administrator, the full usage fee will be refunded. The administrator shall not be responsible for any other expenses incurred.

- (3) The administrator shall not be liable for loss or theft of valuables, damage caused by natural disasters, or injuries resulting from accidents or troubles (including human casualties) occurring within the facility or parking areas, except in cases caused by management negligence
- (4) Personal information will not be used for purposes other than Campground operations. However, it may be disclosed or provided when required for legal duties by national or local government agencies or parties commissioned by them.

9. Restoration to Original Condition and Compensation for Damages

- (1) After use of the facilities or upon revocation of approval for use, users must immediately restore the site to its original condition.
- (2) If facilities or equipment are damaged or lost due to user negligence, the user must immediately report to the center and submit a Facility Damage/Loss Report (Form No. 3) to the administrator. Users shall bear the actual costs required for restoration.

10. Other

If an emergency such as a serious incident, accident, or fire occurs at night, promptly contact emergency services (110 for police, 119 for fire/ambulance).

Supplementary Provisions

These regulations shall come into effect on April 1, 2023.

These revised regulations shall come into effect on February 1, 2026.
